USW Application Information

1. Proposed Program

- Bachelor Program / Master Program / Doctoral Program

2. Eligibility and Requirements

- Bachelor Course (No less than 8 semesters)
- Master Course (No less than 4 semesters)
- Doctoral Course (No less than 6 semesters)
- All applicants are required to have their degree as of February, 2017 at a domestic or foreign graduate school.

(A) Applicants are selected based on the results of both document screening and interview.

(B) In case the applicant's qualification does not meet the admission criteria of USW, USW has the authority not to select anyone regardless of the number of applicants.

3. Selection Process

- (A) Documents screening
- (B) Video Interview

4. Required Documents

- (A) Application Form with one photo (3cmx4cm)
- (B) Official Language Test minimum Scores - TOPIK3, IELTS5.5, TOEFL530(Ibt71) : All applicants might submit one of them
- (C) Study Plan
- (D) Certificates of Graduation from graduate schools you have attended.
- (E) Transcripts from graduate schools you have attended (expressed as a percentage)
 - In case of transfer students, submit his/her transcripts of previous schools.
- (F) One photo (3*4)
- (G) Copy of License(s) (Applicants who have technical license(s), architectural license(s), etc.)

※ Applicants who have bachelor's or higher degree from foreign universities are required to submit additional documents as specified below.

(1) Certificates of graduation and transcripts must be in English and stamped "NOTARIZED"
