Eligibility

- Must be on track to have completed at least five semesters of study by July 2020 with a competitive GPA. Must meet the UQ English language proficiency before April 2020.
- The opportunity is not open to currently enrolled UQ students or students studying at UQ on study abroad or exchange.

Application deadline

30 April for Semester 2 commencement.

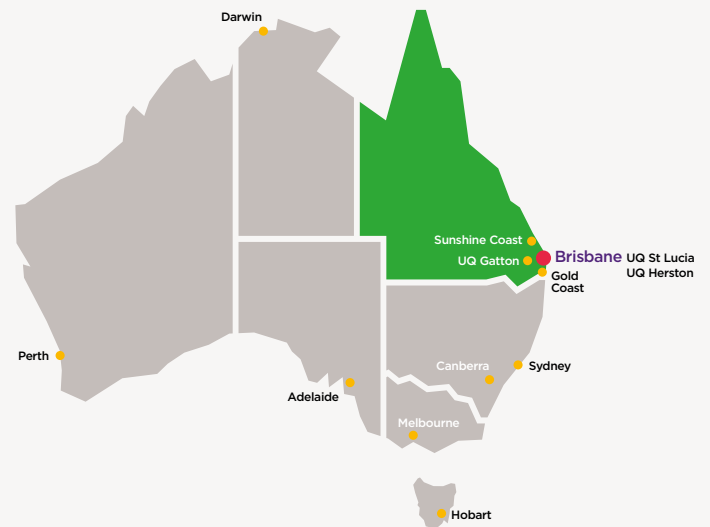
Welcome to Queensland
